

STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT

SESSION: 2019-20

Students' feedback was collected at the time of form fill up before university final examination from the students with 'good attendance' and good result. Questions were aimed at getting information on facilities and resources provided for teaching-learning, and to assess sincerity of the students as learners.

The Students Satisfaction Survey highlights the satisfaction of the students relating to a. Attendance, b. Syllabus covered, c. Teachers Performance, d. Academic and co-curricular activities, and f. Infrastructural facilities.

All the students expressed satisfaction for having teachers' cooperation always served in need. Quality lectures teaching assignments or routine allocation are stupendously helpful according to them. Many supported the fixity of core classrooms and ample provision for smart classes. Construction of new buildings provides scope for more classrooms. Availability of drinking water is overall good and making provision for ample drinking water is appreciated by many students.

Majority of the students are satisfied with the distribution of classes in the routine and commented that above 90% of their syllabi were completed. About 90% of the students said classrooms facilities are 'excellent'. Most of the students find media-centre and ICT aided teaching-learning and interactive teaching methods encouraging. Teachers are punctual, sincere and academically sound. Their delivery of lectures is informative and helpful. They maintain a warm and cordial relation with the students and help them out in moments of crisis. The students commented positively on departmental quiz, seminar, and related activities for advanced learners. Almost all the Departments organize Departmental Seminars, Debates and Quizzes in which the participation of the students are made compulsory. Most of the students find library resources, service, borrowing and reading room facilities 'very good'. Students of science departments commented that laboratory facilities, number of practical classes held and cooperation of the teachers and laboratory staff are 'excellent'. Majority of the students are satisfied with the cooperation of Non-teaching staff and the Principal.
